

If the aim is to improve our organisations, we're going to need a measure of where we are now. Delegates clearly felt that there's a way to go.






# Team performance

That's entirely possible, but is it accurate?






## Our performance

Many delegates also believed they are more collaborative than their colleagues.


People tend to feel 'above average' at most things. It's known as Illusory Superiority.

Even if they are better than others at this collaboration business, many delegates could think of at least one recent occasion when they could have done more.






#### The context for collaboration




A challenging insight into the context for efforts to improve collaboration in delegates' organisations.
